

Islamic Finance

ISLM <Go>

displays a menu of functions and data related to Islamic capital markets.

ISLB <Go>

displays a list of *sukuk*, or Islamic bonds, which are backed by physical assets and pay profit rates instead of the interest that's prohibited under Islam's Shariah principles.

NIM16 <Go>

displays new issues of Islamic bonds.

SUKU <Go>

displays a list of international Islamic bonds.

SUKD <Go>

displays a list of domestic Islamic bonds.

ISCT <Go>

displays a list of Islamic certificates.

ISLN <Go>

displays a list of Islamic loans from around the world.

SRCH <Go>

lets you search for Islamic bonds by issuer, country or other criteria.

EQS <Go>

lets you screen for companies that comply with Shariah principles.

LSRC <Go>

lets you search for Islamic loans by borrower, industry or other criteria.

FSRC <Go>

lets you search for funds that comply with Shariah.

LEAG <Go>

lets you generate and display league tables for underwriters of Islamic debt.

MISI <Go>

lets you access MSCI Islamic market indexes.

DJGI <Go>

lets you access Dow Jones Islamic market indexes.

MKIS <Go>

lets you access market data and rates for Malaysian Islamic capital markets.

MARC <Go>

lets you access ratings from Malaysian Rating Corp.

ICMW <Go>

displays a menu of links to Islamic market Web sites.

IJIS <Go>

lets you access market data and rates for Indonesian Islamic capital markets.

NI ISLAMFIN <Go>

displays headlines of news stories related to Islamic finance.

OTC <Go>

lets you monitor key rates in emerging markets, including those in Islamic countries like Saudi Arabia.



TOP GULF <Go>

displays headlines of the day's top news stories related to the Middle East.

NI LEAG CRL <Go>

lets you access league tables for Islamic capital markets and nations such as Malaysia.

ISMC <Go>

displays a menu of Islamic-finance contributors' pages.

MEGO <Go>

lets you access information related to Middle Eastern governments.

CDR IM <Go>

displays a settlement and holiday calendar for Islamic markets.

NI ARABWRAP <Go>

displays headlines of market wrap-up news stories for Islamic countries.

EMMV <Go>

lets you monitor the primary index and rates for emerging-market countries, including Islamic nations in Africa, Asia and the Middle East.

WEI <Go>

monitors equity indexes, including those of Islamic countries.
